Dance and cheer friends are the best! It's so easy to get along with people who have the same interests and passion as you. Throughout the year at Vibe, we have a number of themed weeks where students can get dressed up and the studio gets decorated. Our absolute favourites are Mother's and Father's Week leading up to Mother's and Father's Day where parents are invited to take class with their children. These weeks are always a hit!



THE OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE IT MORE SERIOUSLY

We are very proud to offer classes for those who want to have a bit of fun each week as well as for those who want to take their dance and cheer more seriously all under one roof. We have a number of extremely successful elite dance and cheer programs that recreational students might one day like to look into. The opportunity is there and recreational classes are a great stepping stone to get a feel for their interest in dance and/or cheer.



THE MINIMAL COMMITMENT REQUIRED

Because the aim of our recreational classes is to have fun, we don't ask for a crazy amount of commitment. With most classes working towards a performance every 6 months, students are only required for one or two extra days for their performance and dress rehearsal/photo day on top of their weekly class. To make it easier for everyone involved, we encourage students to commit until after the performance they're working on. However, we understand students may miss a class or two. We also don't ask families to spend money on an in-class uniform.

VIBE VALUES

INCLUSIVITY

Dance should be open to everyone, regardless of their age, gender, skill level, background or physical ability. The value of inclusivity ensures that every student feels welcome, accepted, and valued within the community. It celebrates and embraces differences and cultivates an environment where every student can thrive without discrimination or prejudice.

KINDNESS

Kindness refers to the quality of being friendly, generous and considerate. When students, teachers, staff and family members display kindness towards one another in the studio, a positive atmosphere is created. This positive atmosphere encourages dancers to be more comfortable expressing themselves creatively. By taking risks and trying new things, dancers develop their confidence and resilience, which are attributes that can be applied far beyond dancing. It helps to create a positive and supportive community where dancers can thrive and grow both as dancers and as individuals.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Sportsmanship refers to the act of showing respect, fairness and generosity towards one's opponents, teammates, and officials in a competitive setting. Sportsmanship can include behaviours such as congratulating others on their successes, supporting those who are struggling, following the rules and guidelines of the studio and demonstrating an overall attitude of positivity and encouragement. When dancers display sportsmanship, they accept both their successes and their failures with grace and learn to see setbacks as opportunities for growth and progress.

JOY

Joy refers to a feeling of great pleasure and happiness. Dance is primarily an art form that is supposed to evoke emotions and feelings of delight and pleasure. Therefore, it is essential for students and instructors alike to embrace the value of joy in dance. Creating a joyous atmosphere motivates and inspires dancers and teachers to reach greater heights. Those who are encouraged to have fun as they train are more likely to develop a passion for their chosen activity and continue with it throughout their lifetime. The feeling of joy is contagious and spreads from one person to another. If everyone involved is having a good time, it makes it easier to work together and create memories that extend beyond the studio walls.

RESPECT

Respect is embodied in the way that the community interacts with one another, the instructors, the studio and the art form itself. There is a need for respect of the studio's facilities and equipment. Students and teachers should also demonstrate reliable behaviours such as arriving on time to class, dressing appropriately and treating each other with respect and attentiveness. These small yet meaningful gestures help to maintain a productive and positive learning environment for all students. Respect also means being open to feedback, adjusting behaviours and accepting constructive criticism. Parents play a vital role in promoting respect. They are a crucial part of the dance community and help to create a supportive and encouraging environment for the dancers. Parents are encouraged to model respect and set an example for their children when interacting with others in the dance studio.

FACILITIES

Vibe Studios is located at 5-6/120 Canterbury Rd, Kilsyth South VIC 3137 and includes:

- a large reception area with a drinks fridge and an ice-cream freezer,
- 4 large dance rooms fitted with full length mirrors and viewing windows,
- 1 small dance room fitted with full length mirrors,
- a 9-run sprung cheer floor,
- a 4-run sprung cheer floor,
- accessible toilets with a baby change table,
- change cubicles and lockers,
- a staff room, and
- split system heating and air conditioning in the reception area, staff room and Dance Room 1.



CLASS

Options

ACRO

Ages: Under 7/9

In this class, students work on their flexibility and learn acrobatic skills that can be incorporated into dance routines. Some of these skills include chin stands, cartwheels, walkovers, and aerials.

ALL ABILITIES

Ages: Adult

We are very proud to offer dance classes to people with special abilities. At Vibe Studios, we believe that everyone deserves to love dance. Our All Ability lessons are very interactive. We work to enhance the gross and fine motor skills of all participants whilst having lots of fun at the same time.

BALLET

Ages: Under 7, Under 9 & Under 12

Ballet is the foundation of dance and is the most technical class a dancer can participate in. We highly recommend ballet classes for those who wish to take their dance more seriously. In our ballet classes, students work on posture, breathing, balance, strength, flexibility, weight transference, and general ballet technique. The strength and control learned in these classes is an incredibly valuable asset to any dance style.

BOOT CAMP

Ages: Adult

In this class, fitness and fun go hand in hand, so we make sure to mix up our workouts with plenty of laughter and camaraderie. During the class, you can expect to participate in various exercises, including cardio, strength training, core work, and more. Our trainer will encourage everyone to push themselves to their limits, but they also know how to make you smile and have fun along the way.

BREAK

Levels: Beginner & Intermediate/Advanced

Break dancing, also referred to as b-boying/b-girling, is an athletic style of street dance. It is typically set to hip hop music and consists mainly of four kinds of movement: toprock (foot movement performed from a standing position), downrock (floor-based footwork), power moves (relying on speed, momentum, and acrobatic elements), and freezes (halting all body motion).

CECCHETTI BALLET

Levels: Grade 1, Grade 2, Grade 4, Grade 6 & Intermediate

At Vibe Studios, we teach the Cecchetti syllabus. Cecchetti is an internationally recognised system of training which offers:

- a gradually built, sound ballet technique while encouraging a love of music and dance
- a graded, developmental syllabus, relevant to today's children
- a system to suit the young beginner right through to the pre-professional dancer
- further opportunities with specialised master classes by leading professionals
- exclusive competitions throughout the year
- a high standard in its teacher training program
- extensive continual professional development opportunities for its teachers
- assurance that teachers hold the qualifications necessary to correctly educate both the recreational student and the dancers of tomorrow.

Cecchetti Ballet Australia has been training ballet teachers and students since 1934 and is taught at many leading dance schools including the Victorian College of the Arts Secondary School and the Ministry of Dance. In these classes, students are taught set exercises that are aimed at developing their ballet technique. Students who are ready have the option of performing these exercises in front of a Cecchetti examiner at the Ministry of Dance. They receive a report that is written up by the examiner with a mark, as well as a certificate.

CHEER

Ages: Under 7, Under 9 & Under 12/14

This is a fast-paced class that involves a lot of teamwork. The elements of cheerleading include stunting, tumbling, jumps, pyramids, and dance.

CONTEMPORARY/LYRICAL

Ages: Under 7, Under 9 & Under 12

This style is one of our favorites! It can range from a strange angular style to soft graceful movements. It is a very free style that we try to change up for each class concert to concert.

Please note that we have not provided our actual 2024 timetable as it is likely to move around before the year begins. Please continue to monitor our website for the most up to date timetable.

HIP HOP

Ages/Levels: Under 7, Under 9, Under 12, Under 14 & 14+ /Advanced

Hip hop is a street dance that is primarily performed to hip hop music. The commercialisation of hip hop means that it can now be seen in film clips by music artists such as Chris Brown and Jason Derulo. Though hip hop is established in entertainment, it maintains a strong presence in urban neighborhoods which has led to the creation of street dance derivatives like Baltimore, jerkin', krumping, and c-walking.

JAZZ

Ages: Under 7, Under 9, Under 12 & Under 14

Our jazz classes involve quick movements that match the fast-paced and popular songs that we love. In these classes, students work on technique, flexibility and performance. You can find things like high kicks, turns, shimmies and of course jazz hands!

MUSICAL THEATRE

Ages: Under 7, Under 9, Under 12 & Under 14/14+

This is a very fun class that combines elements of singing, acting and dancing. In these classes, students practice these skills to soundtracks from popular musicals such as 'Wicked', 'Matilda' and 'Aladdin'.

POINTE

Levels: Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

Pointe is traditional ballet. This class involves dancing in pointe shoes on the tips of fully extended feet. To take part in this class, dancers must have broad experience in ballet, and must also see and gain approval from a physio and a podiatrist.

POM

Ages: Under 7, Under 9, Under 12 & Under 14/14+

Pom is a technical dance style that focuses heavily on strength to create striking visuals. Of course, these visuals are created with pom poms.

SFD JAZZ

Levels: 4, 6, 8 & 10

At Vibe Studios, we offer the Southern Federation of Dance syllabus in the style of jazz. In these classes, students are taught set exercises that are aimed at developing their jazz technique. Students who are ready have the option of performing these exercises in front of an SFD examiner who comes to Vibe Studios. They receive a report that is written up by the examiner with a mark, as well as a certificate and medal.

SINGING

Ages/Levels: Under 9 & 9+

In the singing class, students will learn the fundamentals of singing techniques such as vocal warm-ups, breathing exercises, and proper posture. The class will focus on developing the student's vocal range, tone, pitch, and control to improve their overall singing abilities. This class is perfect for beginners or those who want to improve their singing skills and gain confidence in their voice.

TAP

Ages: Under 7/9 & Under 12

In these classes, students make sounds with their tap shoes by striking the floor as a form of percussion. One of the benefits of participating in tap classes is learning to understand timing and rhythm. This is of benefit to all other styles of dance.

TUMBLING

Level: Novice 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5

In this class, students work on their tumbling skills that are required for cheerleading and useful for dance. Some of these skills include cartwheels, walkovers, handsprings, tucks and layouts.

IN CLASS

Uniform

Wearing the correct dance wear to class is of utmost importance for several reasons. Firstly, it allows dancers to move freely and comfortably. It promotes a sense of unity and belonging among dancers. Lastly, wearing the appropriate dance wear helps instructors assess and correct dancers' technique more effectively. We are excited to announce that in 2024 we will be selling Vibe branded dance wear offering dancers a stylish and high-quality option to further enhance their dance experience. Ballet students are required to wear a leotard and our recreational classes do require specific footwear. This footwear is required for performances and in classes to practice in. School uniforms, dresses and jeans are unacceptable to wear to class.

Opportunities

CHEER TROUPE

Our Cheer Troupe teams work together anywhere between 1-3 hours per week on a competition routine and are also required to do a one hour tumbling class per week on top of this to work on their individual skills. For more information on our Cheer Troupe program, please see our Cheer Troupe Information Pack.

CHOREOGRAPHY COMP

Held in April, our annual Choreography Competition gives all students at Vibe Studios the opportunity to create and perform their own routine. Students can enter as a soloist or with peers as a duo/trio. We have a supportive audience of friends, family and peers. A guest judge who is not involved with Vibe comes in and critiques the choreography. We have extra competitions throughout the day for jazz, lyrical and hip hop improvisation. Every participant receives a certificate and there are also many ribbons, medals, trophies and vouchers to be won.

DANCESTEP

DanceStep is a worldwide student teacher education program designed by Dance Studio Success founder Jane Grech. Each level requires 20 practical hours of assistant teaching and is generally one year in duration. There is also an online learning portal tailored to the learning needs and ages of students. Whether considering a career in dance teaching or otherwise, DanceStep is a great preparation for many aspects of life. At our studio, students can apply to be a part of this program from the age of 13 by contacting us at reception and filling out an application form.

HIP HOP TROUPE

Our Hip Hop Troupe teams work together for 1-1.5 hours per week on a competition routine. On top of that, they are also required to do one recreational class under the hip hop branch per week. For more information on our Hip Hop Troupe program, please see our Hip Hop Troupe Information Pack.

POM TROUPE

Our Pom Troupe teams are mostly made up of Shooting Stars students who are already doing 4-6 hours of training per week. However, we do have a novice stream within the program. Our novice stream is for our dancers who also want to experience the competition world and be pushed more than they would in a recreational class, but don't need to commit to too many hours of training. PRIVATE LESSONS

Any student at Vibe can book a private lesson with one of our teachers to help catch them up or excel further. These lessons can involve working on technique, skills or choreography/exam exercises. Private lessons in 2024 will cost \$1.30 per minute for one student and can be booked in any style as a once off or on a permanent basis. Private lessons can also be shared between 2-3 students. SHOOTING STARS

Shooting Stars is our dance program for students who want to take dance more seriously and compete in Jazz and Lyrical. Our Shooting Stars teams have anywhere between 4-6 classes per week on two different days and have a strict in class uniform.
